## Sports Premium Statement

All schools will receive government funding until 2020 to increase pupil participation in PE and School Sport activities. Each school receives £8000 + £5 per child (above the 17<sup>th</sup> child on the school roll.) This money is to be spent on new initiatives within the school that will be sustainable once the funding ceases. The school is accountable for the spending of this money and the school governors as well as Ofsted will check on its use and impact. In 2017 and 2018, this money was increased to £16000 + £5 per child (above the 17<sup>th</sup> child on the school roll).

At Studlands Rise First School we have a clear action plan of how this money will be spent – this is available separately ‘Sports Premium Action Plan.’
