



Studlands Rise First School Uniform Policy.

We have a simple, affordable uniform and expect children to look smart.

Children can wear plain school colours (royal blue and grey) or some items can also be purchased with the school logo on. The logo is not compulsory. Most of our plain uniform can be purchased from shops and supermarkets. Grey shorts or trousers
Grey skirts or pinafore dresses
White polo shirts (plain or with logo) or cotton blouses/shirts
Royal blue jumper or cardigan (plain or with logo)
White or grey socks or grey tights
Black shoes
Pair of plimsolls for indoor use
Summer – blue and white gingham dress (Optional)

Navy shorts
White T shirt (plain or with logo)
Plain dark (navy or black) jogging bottoms
Plain dark (navy or black) tracksuit for winter months
Trainers

We take the children out in most weathers so they always need wellingtons in school and suitable outdoor clothing for wet weather. In summer, a sunhat is required.

The school has a no jewellery policy, including no earrings, as serious accidents can be caused by jewellery during PE or in normal child's play. Watches may be worn, but must be removed for PE/swimming. They must not be smart watches as this contradicts our e-safety policy. The school cannot be held responsible for the loss of, or damage to, any watches that are worn.

Long hair should be tied back. Headbands, scrunchies or coloured grips should be blue or white in colour.

Children need a named water bottle in school every day as we encourage them to drink water regularly.

All clothing must be clearly named, please.

If you have any financial difficulty in purchasing school uniform, please contact the school to discuss your personal circumstances. For families of children entitled to benefit related Free School Meals or in other financial hardship, we may be able to support by purchasing individual items of uniform or giving good quality second hand uniform.
